USE GOHUNT.COM AND ONX MAPS

- Use online tools to verify best draws by state
- Then use [OnX maps](#) to verify access points

BODY AND MIND READY

- Prepare mentally for a potential long grind when hunting is slow.

GET GREAT OPTICS

- Jay likes 10 and 15 Power Binoculars - Swarovski Optics

SET GUN BARREL FOR SUCCESS

- Set gun barrel to the right of the animal for right handed shooter (increases flexibility if animal moves)

GET GOOD AT ELK CALLING

- Real cadence, tone and sound is the focus

WHAT TO AIM FOR

- Split body in 1/2 vertically and aim in the middle. Then shoot 15 inches behind the shoulder
